


























Expanding the scope of beneficiaries of shelter services by sheltering the category of abused male children over 12 years old in the Emirates Youth Hostel Association.

Adding DFWAC to the Dubai now application.

Diversifying the channels of receiving social and psychological counseling through the launch of the virtual sessions and mobile services initiative.

Upload all DFWAC services via the Linktree platform

Launching qualitative rehabilitation initiatives such as animal assisted therapy and positive parenting.

Participation and raising awareness on the regional campaign on digital extortion in cooperation with the GCC Health Council.

Launching the "Bassma" initiative to activate the positive role of customers in designing and improving care and rehabilitation services.

Obtaining membership in the media committee on the national policy for child protection in educational institutions.

Contribute by preparing an educational and awareness guide on Social Bullying for the National Committee for the Prevention of Bullying in the School Environment. The guide includes scenarios of social bullying forms and methods on how deal to with them for the age group from kindergarten to the third primary school.

Preparing flashcards for building resistance to confront bullying behavior (printed electronic) and adding a special corner for these interactive exercises on the DFWAC electronic application.

The organization received an outstanding percentage of partner relationship happiness (%94).

The organization received an outstanding percentage of customer happiness (%98).

The number of followers of the Foundation's platforms increased by nearly 1500 followers during 2022.

The Foundation completed a study on a national-level titled "Evaluation of Awareness Level about the Crime of Human Trafficking in the United Arab Emirates" in cooperation with Addaera Research and Poll Center.

The number of publications on various media platforms doubled, as the Foundation achieved 865 media bulletins on various media platforms, including 12 radio interviews and two television interviews.

Striving to achieve Dubai's paperless target for the year 2022 by automating some procedures such as purchase orders, completion documents, meetings minutes and contracts.

Interaction on social media channels increased to more than 10,000 and views of campaigns in collaboration with Furjan Dubai increased to more than 17,000 views.

Develop the Foundation's application by adding a children's corner.

Participation in regional studies on the Impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic on Child Protection Services for the year 2021-2022 in the GCC countries – in collaboration with the National Family Safety Program in Saudi Arabia, a regional collaborating center with the World Health Organization.

Electronic link with the Digital Dubai Authority and the Dubai Government Human Resources Department regarding the unified register of Dubai Government employees.

Upgrade DFWAC servers from version 2012 to version 2019/2022.

Approving and implementing the replacement and resettlement plan.

Organizing the ceremony honoring employees 2020-2021.

Providing various activities to make employees happy.

Activating health insurance ENAYA.

Accommodating employees according to the scale of grades of the Human Resources Law of the Government of Dubai.


